



OBDII T-Bypass Short Installation (2019+ Ram 2500 & 3500)

- 1. Cut off the key tab on the green plug using snips or a knife.
- Squeeze the tabs on the sides of the factory OBD2 connector and remove it from the factory bracket.
- 3. Plug the white connector into the block on the Ram that's closer to the driver door it has a lot of plugs that have yellow wires, as shown.
- 4. Plug the green connector into the block on the Ram that's closer to the firewallit has plugs that have white wires.
- 5. Plug the factory OBD2 into the Male OBD2 from the T-Harness.
- 6. Clip the OBD T-Harness female that only has black wires into the factory bracket. You will need to stretch the locking tabs outward first so they can lock into the bracket.
- 7. Tie all the wires up and out of the way.

 The OBD2 female that has the colored wires on the back is for the Tazer to plug into.
